

Deliverable Overview

During Phase Zero the front-end design will emerge through the development of a prototype and several iterations of stakeholder feedback. Additionally the backend architecture will be determined and a proof of concept will be developed. As stakeholders give feedback to the prototype, requirements will be mapped to business process, quick wins will be established, a high-level release plan will be developed along with an iteration plan for the first release. Four iterations of development and feedback will be conducted to produce a prototype. The prototype will be the basis for development of the first release.

Phase Zero Deliverable Details

1. **A front-end prototype** demonstrating the page flow, format, context, and content (including language) for the web interface. The prototype will allow stakeholders to provide feedback through the application.
2. **A backend proof of concept** demonstrating some or all of the architecture components to be used in the solution.
3. **Solution Map** The application requirements demonstrated in the web interface prototype will be mapped to the business processes that apply them. Gaps in business process, or requirements, will be identified so that they may be addressed in Phase One.
